What is a Helping Hand?


A Helping Hand is a spouse, significant other, or relative of a current CASA Volunteer who wants to be involved and serve in a limited capacity and supporting role for a volunteer.



What Can a Helping Hand Do?

The Helping Hand may:

- Visit with the CASA child when accompanied by the primary CASA
- Discuss the case with an Advocate, and only with the Advocate.
- Attend CASA Trainings and Social Activities.

- ### Eligibility Requirements
- The CASA Volunteer must have been active on a case for a minimum of six months.
 - The Helping Hand must be **at least** 21 years old.
 - The Helping Hand must submit a written application, interview with CASA Staff and submit to CPS and criminal background checks.
 - The Helping Hand must complete a 2 hour training.
